Welcome to the City of Newton Falls Refuse and Recycling Guide. As your waste service provider, the Waste Management Team looks forward to continuing to provide courteous and dependable curbside collection to the residents of Newton Falls.

In the latest contract approved by the City of Newton Falls, each residential unit will receive two 18-gallon recycling bins for weekly collection of recyclables. See additional information in this guide on what and how to recycle. Waste Management uses a state of the art "Single Stream" recycling process, which means you can mix and commingle newspapers, plastic bottles, cans, and all recyclables in the bin. There is no need to separate commodities.

What & How



Newspaper/Magazines:

You may recycle junk mail, daily newspapers, newspaper inserts – "glossy" & "non-glossy" – and magazines!

No shredded paper please!

Corrugated Cardboard/ Box Board:

You may recycle all corrugated cardboard and boxboard such as cereal boxes, clothing boxes, gift boxes, detergent boxes, soda or other type of beverage boxes, and shipping and packing boxes.

Please break down all large boxes.



Aluminum Cans:

All aluminum beverage cans
*Please rinse and place in
your recycling container.*



Steel & Bi-Metal Cans:

All steel & bi-metal beverage and food cans.
Please rinse and place in your recycling container.



Plastic:

All plastic numbered 1-7 on the bottom of the container may be recycled.

*Please rinse and place inside
your recycling container.*



Glass:

All green, clear and brown food and beverage containers may be recycled. No other types of glass will be collected.

*Please rinse and place inside
your recycling container.
Labels may remain on bottle/jar.*

Trash Collection Services

Recyclables and trash will be collected **AT THE CURB** on your current pick-up day, each by a separate truck. Please place containers and bins at curbside by 6:00 a.m. Curbside refers to that portion of right of way adjacent to the paved or traveled city streets.

Preparing Items For Collection

Newton Falls Ordinance 981.02:

Refuse shall be set out in proper containers on collection day, at curbside, by 6:00 a.m. and removed by sundown of collection day.

ALL refuse must be contained, tied or enclosed to prevent leaking, spilling or blowing. It must not exceed 50 pounds in weight. Branches must be no longer than 4 feet in length, 4 inches in diameter and must be bundled and tied.

Waste Management will not be responsible for removal of freon from all appliances.

Latex paint in cans should have lids removed and paint permitted to air dry to a hard substance. Paint cans should not be bagged.

Low Volume Service Program

Low Volume generators may be interested in purchasing Orange Waste Management bags from Newton Falls Utility Office.

Under this program, 5-count rolls of 30 gallon bags are available from the city, and can be used in lieu of full service for those households that generate a small amount of waste weekly.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

The following holidays will be observed:

New Years Day
Memorial Day
Independence Day
Labor Day
Thanksgiving
Christmas Day

If a holiday falls on a weekday, your trash will be collected the day after your regular pick up day.

If the holiday falls on the weekend, normal pick up will not be interrupted.

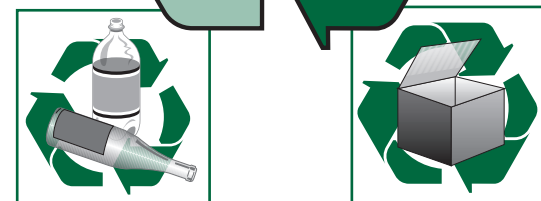
