

ORDINANCE 2014-12

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH NEWTON FALLS SCHOOL DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, The City of Newton Falls provides electric services to the Newton Falls School District; and

WHEREAS, Issues have arisen which indicate there has been a discrepancy in the billing to the School District; and

WHEREAS, Both the City and the School District have explored settlement of any uncharged and unpaid electric utility bills; and

WHEREAS, A settlement has been proposed which would satisfy the School District account which is in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to amicably settle this matter for the benefit of both the City and the School District.

COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF NEWTON FALLS, STATE OF OHIO,
HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION I: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a settlement agreement with the Newton Falls School District to satisfy any claim the City may have for recovery of money due for the providing of electric services. Said agreement marked "Exhibit A" attached hereto and made a part hereof as if fully rewritten herein.
