## **ORDINANCE 2014-21**

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL OF RED FLASHING SIGNAL LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTION OF ARLINGTON AND WARREN ROAD.

WHEREAS, At the request of the City the Trumbull County Engineers Office had a study conducted to determine the need of Red Flashing Traffic Signal "Red Beacon" located at the intersection of Arlington and Warren Road; and

WHEREAS, The signal was installed to facilitate convenience and safety of student pedestrian traffic for Arlington Elementary School which was located within one mile of the intersection. Since that time, approximately 5 years ago, Arlington school was consolidated and moved to Milton Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Section 4B.02 (04) of the Procedure for Traffic Signal Removal Form are considered for changing the traffic patterns and eliminating the need of traffic control signals. Which are no longer justified and the decision was made to remove the signal;

WHEREAS, Based upon the criteria, it is the opinion of the Engineer to remove the Red Flashing signal at the intersection of Arlington and Warren Road.

THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF NEWTON FALLS, STATE OF OHIO, HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION I: Newton Falls City Council, on the recommendation of the Trumbull County Engineer, hereby authorize the City Manager to have the traffic signal located at the intersection of Arlington and Warren Road removed, as the signal is not justified at this location as stated in the report marked "Exhibit A" attached hereto as if fully rewritten herein .

SECTION II: Any ordinance or parts of ordinance in conflict with the context of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
