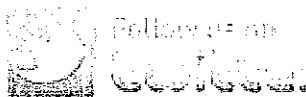

Good afternoon,

My apologies for sending this out late, but here is some information I owe you all.

Here is our response when we are asked about outbreaks in any setting:

Thank you for reaching out to the Ohio Department of Health. Our Ohio Disease Reporting System (ODRS) is a person-based disease incidence reporting system that does not index information based on outbreak or occupation. Rather, the system indexes information based entirely by individual and disease. ODRS also does not have a search mechanism and we would have to review each case to see if there was a connection or if and employment location was even listed. Therefore, we cannot produce a comprehensive list of the information you are requesting.

Girl Scout meetings:

They can not operate in the day camp mold. These would still be a mass gathering and needs to be kept to under 10 people at this time.

NA/AA Meetings:

Yes, NA/AA meetings can have more than 10 individuals at a meeting. Although we should stress following all the usual safety measures, wear masks, social distance, have good air flow in the room, no open food—only prepackaged food (if there are snacks or coffee)

City Council Meetings:

Yes, they can meet in person and be over the 10 person limit. This is viewed as a first amendment gov't function.
