JOURNEYMAN LINEMAN

Electric Division
Public Works Department

NATURE OF WORK:

A full-time or part-time hourly position, that is appointed by the City Manager and works under the direct supervision of the Superintendent in the Electric Division of the Public Works Department or an assigned supervisor. Responsible for constructing, operating & maintaining electric power distribution & transmission facilities and the interior wiring of City owned facilities.

EXAMPLES OF WORK:

- Constructs, operates, & maintains the City's electric power distribution & transmission facilities & systems.
- ❖ Performs all wiring on energized systems & facilities.
- ❖ Sets poles, sizes/hangs transformers, sizes & installs wire, fuses, and residential service.
- Tests & adjusts single-phase meters.
- Installs secondary voltage charts, streetlights and traffic lights, controllers & timers.
- Installs & repairs interior wiring.
- Trims trees around secondary & primary services.
- Operates a variety of vehicles & equipment.
- Climbs utility poles using hooks & safety belt.
- Reads meters in the system that record performance and records the necessary data.
- * Reads water and/or electric meters, as directed.
- Performs such other tasks, as may be assigned.

- Graduate of a technical school or training program with an emphasis in electricity.
- Able to develop excellent skills in working with electricity and electrical tools & equipment.
