A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING OHM ADVISORS TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF NEWTON FALLS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT

PROGRAM(S) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY
AGREEMENTS THAT MAY BE NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE FOR OBTAINING
THIS FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements for public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Newton Falls desires to make capital improvements to its roads through its 2023 Paving Program; and

WHEREAS, the above described 2023 Paving Program infrastructure improvements are considered a priority need for the community and constitute a qualified program under the Ohio Public Works Commission programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Newton Falls, Ohio:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> That OHM Advisors, the Village's Project Engineer, is hereby authorized to apply to the Ohio Public Works Commission for funds as described above.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager of Newton Falls is hereby authorized to enter into any agreements that may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance, and Council hereby acknowledges it will be required to appropriate and/or authorize the financing of any required matching funds in the event a grant is awarded to and accepted by the Village.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> That all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption in accordance with Article III, Section 22 of the Charter of Newton Falls.
