A RESOLUTION ALLOCATING AND DESIGNATING THE PROPERTIES KNOWN AS 110 BROAD STREET AND 116 BROAD STREET AS THE FUTURE LOCATION FOR A NEW WATER TOWER ONCE THE EXISTING WATER TOWER NEEDS TO BE REPLACED

WHEREAS, the Village is reviewing its options with respect to repairing dams, sourcing water for the water treatment facility, and relocating the water tower once it needs to be replaced, and is engaged in planning and seeking grants for same; and

WHEREAS, in order to assist with the above efforts, Council desires to allocate and designate the old William Ballantine property known as 110 and 116 Broad Street as the future location for a new water tower once the existing water tower reaches its useful life span, which is estimated to occur within the next ten years, and needs to be replaced.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Newton Falls, Ohio:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> That Council hereby and herein allocates and designates the properties known as 110 Broad Street (Parcel No. 53-078500) and 116 Broad Street (Parcel No. 53-115430) as the future location for a new water tower once the existing water tower reaches its useful life span, which is estimated to occur within the next ten years, and needs to be replaced.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> That all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council or any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were taken in meetings open to the public and/or in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption in accordance with Article III, Section 22 of the Charter of Newton Falls.
